These Great Fifty Days of Easter can be powerful ones for us  
as we hear gospel stories of Jesus' resurrection appearances  
to the disciples huddled together in grief and fear.

Just as the disciples needed to hear the words  
"Peace be with you. Do not be afraid."  
so do those among us who have had a loved one die.  
Like Thomas, we need to acknowledge the wounds and wonder  
"How can we know the way to where you are going?"

One way we can claim the resurrection and wonder about our loved ones  
is to gather together to tell stories  
to share our wounds and  
to look for resurrection.

In one of his horror novels Stephen King spoke a truism about the grieving process.  
"Grief is like the drunken houseguest who keeps coming back for one last hug."  
We never know when the houseguest will appear –  
it may be right after the death  
it may be 10 years later stirred by a familiar scent.

We can, however, be intentional about standing with each other  
and speaking words of comfort and peace.  
For that reason, Saint Margaret's is forming a grief support group –  
maybe we should call it a "resurrection" group  
for those who have experienced a death in the last year or so.

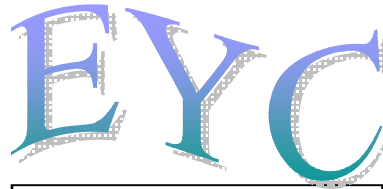
If you feel the group may be helpful in your grieving process, please join us.

July 9 – 15, 2006.

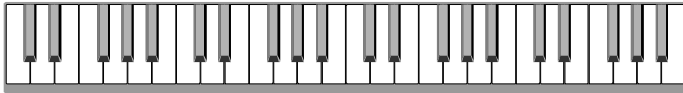

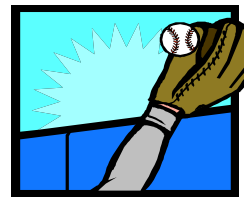


