and become his love in the joys and sorrows of our world.

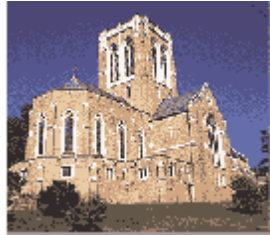
## EASTER MEMORIALS / HONORARIUMS
