From the Rector

For the first time in the five years that I have been at St Margaret's the Palm Sunday procession did not wind through the garden and in through the front red doors of the church. Instead, as rain fell outside, we waved our palms in the parish hall and then traveled through the kitchen down the hall and into the nave door near the pulpit. Our route adjustment would have been more complicated if we traditionally incorporated a live donkey (the ultimate visual aid) into the liturgical drama.

Some parishes do use a donkey.

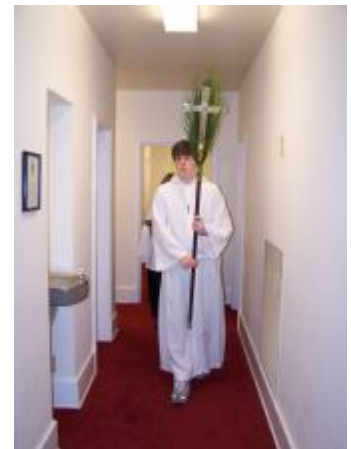
In fact, I was talking to a priest the other day who said the cathedral where he currently serves uses the animal. "Who gets to ride the donkey?" I asked. "A child is chosen each year. It's a real big deal." (I can deal with a little rain. However, I would not want to be the one who selected which child would portray Jesus and get to ride in the parade.)

Holy Week is all about experiencing the ancient drama of Jesus' journey from hosannas to horror. The details of our liturgies may vary but the basic ingredients are consistent.

*Eat, drink, remember. Love one another.  
Watch and pray. Stay with me.  
Today you will be with me in paradise.  
Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.  
Into your hands I commend my spirit  
It is finished!*

Holy Week is a powerful reminder that no matter where our lives take us...rain or shine... or in the dark of night... Jesus has been there before us and walks with us now. His love is a real big deal.

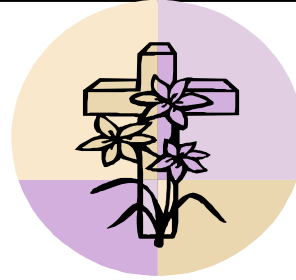


ECW will meet on Tuesday, April 10 at 1200 noon in the parish hall. Please bring a sack lunch.

### DIOCESE OF ATLANTA ACOLYTE FESTIVAL SLATED FOR APRIL 28 AT CATHEDRAL

Acolytes of all ages will gather at 9 a.m. Saturday, April 28, at the Cathedral of St. Philip for the Diocese of Atlanta's Acolyte Festival. The day will culminate with a grand procession and Holy Eucharist at 2 p.m. in the Cathedral nave.

Sponsored by the Diocesan Commission on Liturgy, the day will feature 10 workshops on topics ranging from serving the altar to streamer making and the Anglican rosary. A cathedral tour also is planned. Cost will be \$15 to cover materials and lunch.

Ben Wells is the festival organizer. "We really want all parishes to participate and send representatives," Wells said. "Everyone is invited to the closing Eucharist; the grand procession should be quite a special!"

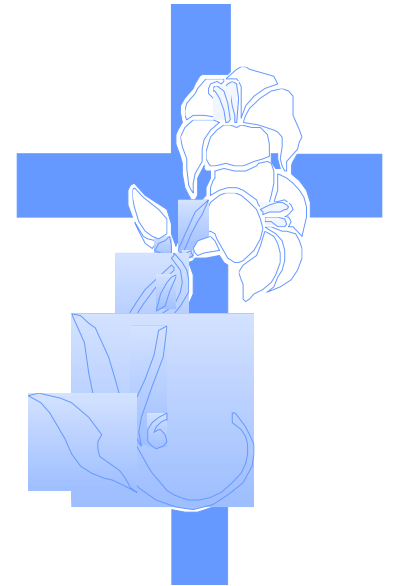
