Dear Fellow Members of St. Margaret's:

The vestry is committed to maintaining our assets, and at the beginning of the year, as Senior Warden I asked Wilton Key, Bob Swanson, and George Lenaeus to examine last year's inspection report of the Gable House, and prioritize the needed repairs. In the meantime, many of you approached me about the dark streaks on the wall directly behind the altar which are being caused by the oil in the candles.

I had Wilton Key get an estimate from a professional painter, and when it was presented, two members of the congregation voluntarily donated a sum of money to partially cover the cost of the painting. Then, another member, also wishing to remain anonymous, gave a check to cover the whole cost. Just as we were about to hire the painter, Greg Cary and his crew swooped down, painted the wall,

and made a number of repairs to the Gable House. They saved St. Margaret's a good sum of money. The church is putting the above mentioned donations into a separate account in order to purchase in the future a small separate heat pump for the large room at the rear of the Gable House. Thus, the air and heat can be controlled separately from the offices of Hazel and the staff, saving utility costs. In addition, it will eliminate the unsightly pipe on the roof and if necessary will allow roof repairs to be made more easily.

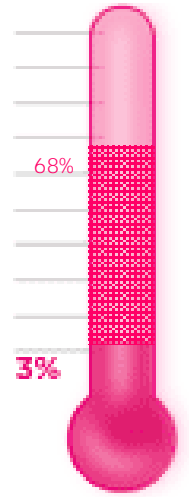


We are now at 68% of our goal. Thank you all for your generous donations to our 3-Day Walk for the Cure Team, Highland Pearls.
