I realize I am experiencing Sabbath when I feel content and at peace.

Rabbi Abraham Heschel has written that

*Sabbath means more than withdrawal from labor and exertion,  
more than freedom from toil, strain or activity of any kind.  
The biblical Sabbath (menuha) is the same as happiness and stillness.  
It is the state in which there is no strife and no fighting,  
no fear and no distrust.*

I know Sabbath as contented peace grounded in simple pleasures.

I also am drawn to the story told by Barbara Brown Taylor.

*In the eulogy at an African American Baptist church the preacher tried  
to comfort the congregation by telling them that the person they loved  
had gone on to that place where every day is Sunday.*

*Sabbath is a time when we completely trust God to take care of us.*

*We no longer depend on our own abilities.*

*We rest in God's abilities.*

Where do you find Sabbath? Where are you at peace? When can you rest in God?

Standing atop a mountain?

In the time warp around the Eucharistic table?

At the beach or in the eyes of a child?

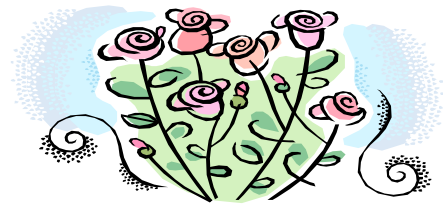
