*Let you clay be moist,*

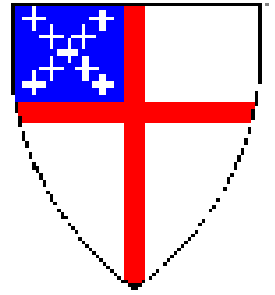
*Lest you grow hard and lose the imprint of

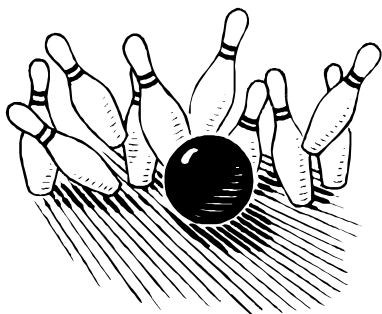
