but also carry on your legacy and glorify God in our lives.

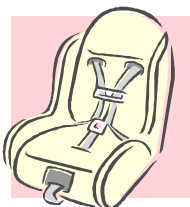

**All VBS Volunteers are asked to attend an orientation meeting this Saturday, June 16<sup>th</sup> at Carrollton Presbyterian Church.**

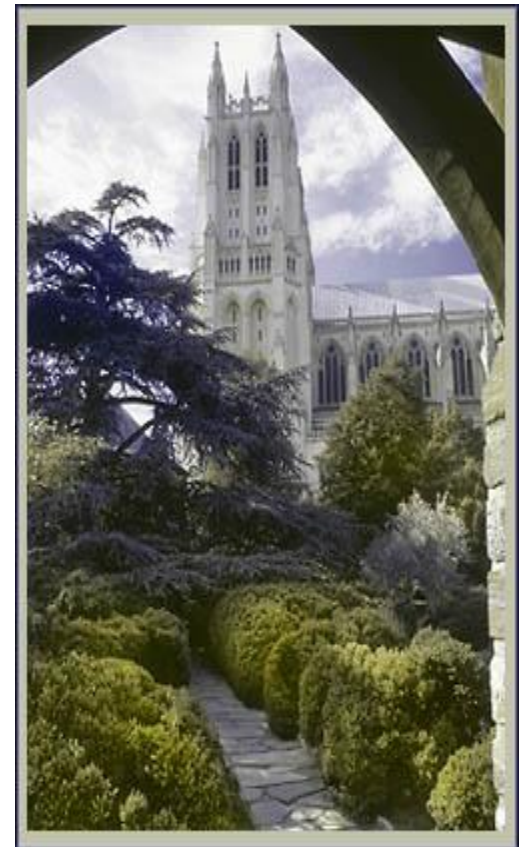
### **J2A Class to embark on Urban Adventure June 22<sup>nd</sup>**

Members of St. Margaret's J2A class, and their adult leaders will leave for Washington, DC early Friday morning and return late Sunday evening. They will be accompanied by Laura Lenaeus, who has planned the trip, and our Rector, The Rev. Hazel Glover. The Urban Adventure is a precursor to the more extensive pre-confirmation Pilgrimage the group will make to Canterbury, England in 2008. Previous groups from St. Margaret's have gone to New York City, Charleston, San Antonio and New Orleans. While on the trip, the young adults are divided into teams that take turns leading the group to pre-selected sites in the destination city. Each group learns where they must lead their peers and chaperones to until their turn comes up. The goal of the trip is for the young people to gain leadership experience and build communication skills before they make their Pilgrimage. Adults are not allowed to "jump in" and take over for the youth, but are available for support and advice when is asked for by the teens. Sites visited are a closely guarded secret until it is time to actually visit them. The theme for this Urban Adventure is "Faith and Courage in Life and Work".

The group will be staying on the grounds of the Washington National Cathedral at the College of Preachers while in Washington. Making the trip will be 11 youth and 7 adults:
