Palm/Passion Sunday

This Sunday marks the beginning of Passiontide (Holy Week) when we will gather to celebrate Palm/Passion Sunday. This day is full of drama and contrasts with two key ritual components of the liturgy; the procession with palm branches and the solemn reading of the Passion. In the beginning of the service we experience the joyous welcoming of Jesus with shouts of “Hosanna.” Everything is festive and celebratory, yet under our shouts lie the pain and suffering of the crucifixion to come. In this service we encounter anew the ambiguity of our own participation in the triumphal entry and the passion of Christ.

The early church in Jerusalem (fourth century) processed with palms on this day taken from the Synoptic Gospels (Matt., Mark & Luke) and this practice spread to other areas of Europe reaching Rome by about the eleventh century. In late medieval Europe the congregation would assemble outdoors before the Eucharist for a blessing of palm branches, reading a relevant gospel and procession around the church. Often

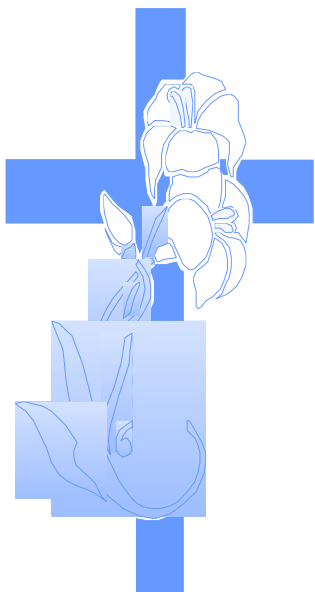
the hymn Gloria, laus et honor (All glory, laud and honor) was sung during this procession. The second part of the service is the solemn reading of the passion taken from Matthew 26: 14-27:66. This lengthy gospel was usually chanted by three ministers, each taking a different role. The tenor voice was the narrator, the bass represented Christ and the alto was all of the other individual parts. Today it is customary (though not required) that the celebrant reads the role of Jesus, the deacon is the narrator and laypeople read all of the other parts.

Some reading suggestions for those looking to deepen their appreciation of our Holy Week traditions are: *The Travels of Egeria* edited by John Wilkinson, *Jerusalem Revisited: The Liturgical Meaning of Holy Week* by Kenneth Stevenson, *Historical Survey of Holy Week: Its Services and Ceremonial* by the Rev. John Walton Tyrer and *This is the Night* by the Rev. Dr. James Farwell (a former priest of our diocese).

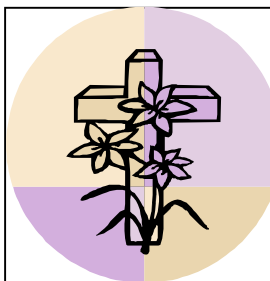
