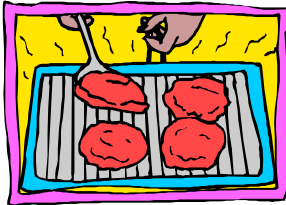

John and Cindy Hull invite the Canterbury J2A Pilgrims, chaperones, and their families to an end of summer blow-out.

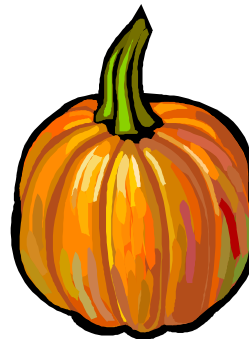
The cook-out is on Sept 20 from 5 - 9 pm. Hot dogs, Burgers, Chips, Drinks, Games, etc.
