was written in response to the Darwin's

Regardless of the writer's motivation,  
I have loved the words written by Cecil Frances Alexander (1848)  
since my youth as part of the children's choir.  
My solo verse one particular Sunday was  
*"The purple headed mountain, the river running by,  
the sunset, and the morning that brightens up the sky."*

I remember my mama whistling the tune around the house.  
In fact, my association with the hymn and mama is so strong  
we sang it at her funeral.

My fondness of the hymn has only grown over the years  
as the hymn is sung at the annual  
Blessing of Animals for the feast day of St. Francis.

Francis of Assisi he was a lover of nature and animals.  
He once said, *"If you have men who will exclude any of God's  
creatures from the shelter of compassion and pity,  
you will have men who will deal likewise with their fellow men."*

I invite you to round up your beloved pets  
and come out to St. Margaret's on Sunday at 4 p.m.  
as we return to our animals  
the blessings and love they so freely give to us.

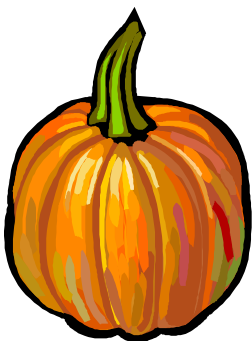
